Are you at risk of hepatitis B

Are you having casual sex or having sex with multiple partners? You are at risk of hepatitis B – **protect yourself with a free vaccine** – available from sexual health clinics.

Hepatitis B virus infects the liver; it is often symptomless but can lead to diseases like cirrhosis and liver cancer. Protect yourself by getting vaccinated, but don't forget to use condoms to protect against hepatitis B and other STIs.
